





































































































Table of Contents

This longish table lists all of the word parts and operations contained in the 20 Word Maps. The bases, prefixes, and suffixes that are linked in words in the maps are linked here by color-coding. Focal bases and prefixes are listed in bold face. Subsidiary bases and prefixes are indented in plain text under the focal base or prefix with which they are linked in the map. Bases are glossed with an example word or a brief definition.

Using the pdf search function – or Ctrl-F – you can find each occurrence of each item in all the maps. The lists of filters, procedures, and processes can be particularly useful for finding topics that you would like to have your students studying.
